§2 Overview of Data Processing

We process the following personal data:

Attendance Recording

For the purpose of recording attendance, you may enter your name in an attendance list.

Data / Categories of Data: Contact Details (Name, Email-Address)

Legal Basis: Art. 6. (1) lit. f DSGVO (Legitimate Interest)

Recipients / Categories of Recipients: The data will be made available within the responsible entity. No further transfer to third parties will take place.

Storage Period: The data will be deleted unless further retention is required for the fulfillment of the processing purpose.

Video Recordings

During our event we may take photos and video recordings for the purpose of documenting the event and promoting our company.

Data/ Categories of Data: Image Data (Photo- and Video Data)

Legal Basis: Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR (Legitimate Interest)

Recipients / Categories of Recipients: The photos and video recordings may be published on our website, on social media and on other platforms.

Storage Period: The data will be deleted unless further retention is required for the fulfillment of the processing purpose.

§3 Your Rights

You have the right,

pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR to obtain information about your personal data processed by us. In particular, you may request information on the purposes of processing, the category of personal data, the categories of recipients to whom your data has been or will be disclosed, the envisaged storage period, the existence of a right to rectification, erasure, restriction of processing or objection, the existence of a right to lodge a complaint, the source of your data if it was not collected from you, and the existence of automated decision-making including profiling and, where applicable, meaningful information about its details;

pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR to obtain without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate or the completion of your personal data stored by us;

pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR to request the erasure of your personal data stored with us, insofar as the processing is not necessary for the exercise of the right to freedom of expression and information, for compliance with a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest, or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims;

pursuant to Art. 18 GDPR to obtain the restriction of processing of your personal data where the accuracy of the data is contested by you, the processing is unlawful but you oppose the erasure, we no longer need the data but you require it for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims, or you have objected to processing pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR;

pursuant to Art. 20 GDPR to receive the personal data you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format or to request the transmission to another controller;

pursuant to Art. 7 (3) GDPR to withdraw your consent at any time with effect for the future. As a result, we may no longer continue the data processing based on this consent for the future; and;

pursuant to Art. 77 GDPR to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority. As a general rule, you may contact the supervisory authority at your habitual residence, place of work or at the place of our company's registered office.

Exceptions

- a) The right to erasure does not apply insofar as the processing is necessary;
- b) To exercise the right to freedom of expression and information;
- c) For compliance with a legal obligation which requires processing under Union or Member State law to which the controller is subject, or for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller;
- d) For reasons of public interest in the area of public health pursuant to Art. 9 (2) (h) and (i) as well as Art.9 (3) DGPR;
- e) For archiving purposes in the public interest, scientific or historical research purposes, or statistical purposes pursuant to Art. 89 (1) GDPR, insofar as the right referred to under (a) is likely to render impossible or seriously impair the achievement of the objectives of such processing, or
- f) For the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims.
